Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 - Section 53

I am writing to advise you that following the advertisement of the Inspector's proposed modification to the above Order, objections/representations have been received.

However, these representations do not cover any of the matters which the Inspector can take into account.

According to paragraph 8(3) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981^[1], the Secretary of State does not have to hold an inquiry or a hearing if, in his opinion, none of the representations or objections received relate to an issue which the Inspector is able to consider. Where this is the case, the Inspector will proceed to make a final decision without reference to those objections/representations.

On this basis, I can confirm that arrangements will now be made for an Inspector to prepare a final decision.
